BRIAN DUNNIGAN

Brian Leigh Dunnigan was born in Detroit, Michigan, but spent his childhood in West Branch and East Lansing, Michigan. He was always fascinated with history and spent his summers on Mackinac Island, Michigan at his family cottage and then working as a guide, interpreter, and curator for the Mackinac Island State Park.

Brian has a Bachelor of Science in History from the University of Michigan, as well as a Masters degree. He later received an additional Masters in Museum Management from Cooperstown New York. In the mid 1970's, Brian was responsible for the construction and running of Historic Fort Wayne in Fort Wayne, Indiana. He then moved to Youngstown, New York and served as the Director of Old Fort Niagara.

In the 1990's, after 17 years of managing Fort Niagara, Brian moved back to Michigan where he became the Curator of Maps and Military History for the William Clements Library at the University of Michigan, and in charge of publications. He also served as the Assistant Director at the Library and retired from U of M as an Emeritus Fellow in 2019.

Brian has written many articles on historical subjects from the War of 1812, Great Lakes History and the French and Indian War which have won both national and regional awards.

He and his wife Candice moved to Jackson five years ago. Prior to this they had a small horse farm in Grass Lake. Their adult son is an archaeologist in the Southwest, and their daughter is with Delta Airlines.

Brian still spends lots of time researching historical data and articles. Prior to his move to Spring Arbor, he was an avid equestrian.
