May Day, May 1

National Day of Prayer, May 5

Cinco de Mayo, May 5

This day celebrates the history of the Mexican army over the French army at the Battle of Puebla in 1862.

Mother's Day, May 8

Mother's Day in the United States was created by Anna Jarvis in 1908, and it became an official holiday in 1914. Jarvis would later denounce the holiday's commercialization and spent the latter part of her life trying to remove it from the calendar.

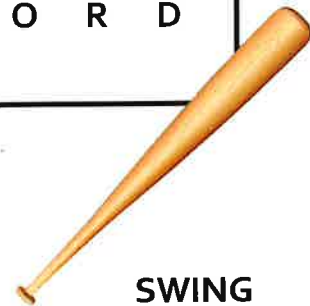
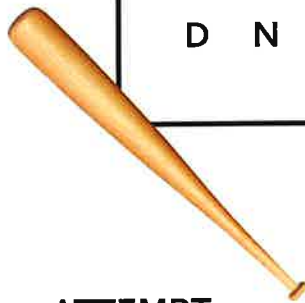
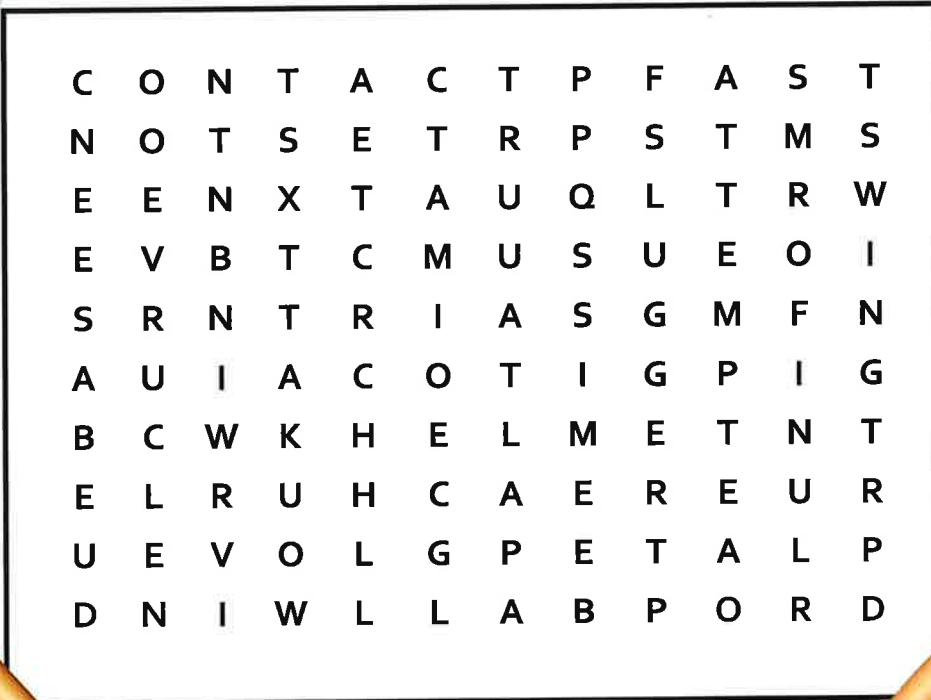
Memorial Day May 30
